



Intel Research Awards

The Intel Corporation will award a research grant to one outstanding student in EACH cluster to help them pursue a research project. The award is open to all 2008 UCSD COSMOS alumni.

Intel supports research by high school students and encourages them to enter their work in science fairs and competitions. The Intel International Science and Engineering Fair is the world's largest pre-college science competition. In an effort to support this cause, we would like to encourage you to stay in contact with your Cluster faculty/staff and consider them a resource.

The award is to be used to support the student's research. The student will be required to submit a two-page progress report of their research by December 30, 2008, via email to cosmos@soe.ucsd.edu. The report should mention plans for evaluation of the work by submission to a science fair/competition or by written evaluation by the student's mentor(s).

To apply, students must send a proposal (one page equivalent) via email to cosmos@soe.ucsd.edu no later than Friday, September 26, 2008 at 4:00pm. The proposal should identify the cluster the student participated in and briefly describe:

- The purpose and importance of the research
- Why the work is original
- Description of proposed work (lab experiments, field studies, etc.)
- How the award would be used (purchase of books, supplies, travel, software, etc., related to the project)
- Who would mentor the student (include title and contact information for mentor)

Awardees will be selected by the instructors for each cluster on the basis of the quality of the proposal and their evaluation of the student's performance and participation in the cluster.

Awards will be announced on Friday, October 31, 2008. Funds will be provided beginning November 30, 2008 by the University of California Office of the President.
